Proposal: Proposed replacement of existing conservatory with garden room. <u>HAPC to respond by 19th August 2022.</u> <u>22/01512/TREE</u> Pumping Station, Rideaway Drive, Hemingford Abbots. Proposal: Elm tree - the team will use pole saws to cut the branches around the building back 1.5m and to a height of 5m, the work will be carried out from ground level. overgrown and is at risk of damaging the building. Also while on site a dead tree was found to have fallen into the site and damaged the fence line and is also now a trip hazard. b) <u>APPROVED</u> <u>22/000563/HHFUL</u> Up Top High Street, Hemingford Abbots, PE28 9A. Internal alterations, demolish existing conservatory and replacement single storey rear and part extension. <u>22/01306/TRCA</u> 64 Common Lane, Hemingford Abbots. Proposal: T1 Thuja: fell to ground level. Tree has been managed as a hedge however is in poor form following recent height reduction T2 Silver Birch: fell to ground level. Tree is declining and approx. 50% dead. <u>22/01188/TRCA</u> Oak Lodge Manor Lane, Hemingford Abbots PE28 9AJ. T1 ash tree to reduce to around 2m stem due to excessive shade and close proximity to building. T2 oak tree to reduce to around 2m stem due to excessive shade and close proximity to building.
